EXAMINATION OF CREDENTIALS

Report of the Credentials Committee

1 Introduction

- 1.1 In accordance with Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Assembly and of the Supplementary Fund Assembly, and Rule 9 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Executive Committee, the 1992 Fund Administrative Council appointed a Credentials Committee consisting of the following five members and their representatives:

- 1.2 The Committee met on 29 October 2018 under the chairmanship of Mr Mostafa Tafryh.

2 Examination of credentials

- 2.1 The credentials of delegations of 65 Member States of the 1992 Fund, including States members of the 1992 Fund Executive Committee and of the Supplementary Fund, were examined.
- 2.2 The Committee based its deliberations on Rules 9 and 11 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Assembly and on the guidelines given in circular [IOPC/2015/Circ.4](#).
