AMENDMENTS TO INTERNAL REGULATIONS

Note by the Secretariat

Summary: This document sets out proposed amendments to the Internal Regulations of the 1992 Fund and the Supplementary Fund in order to take into account changes to the delegation of authority in Internal Regulation 12 as a result of staff changes.

Action to be taken: 1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly

Approve the proposed amendments to the Internal Regulations of the 1992 Fund and the Supplementary Fund, respectively, to take into account the changes to Internal Regulation 12 in respect of the delegation of authority.

1 Introduction

- 1.1 Internal Regulation 12 deals with the delegation of authority in the absence of the Director, which is based on seniority of staff members on the Management Team, in order to act on his behalf in the fulfilment of the functions set out in Article 29 of the 1992 Fund Convention, and to be the legal representative of the 1992 Fund in his absence.
- 1.2 At the December 2020 sessions of the governing bodies, the Director informed the Assembly that, following the departure of the Legal Counsel at the end of June 2020, the Director invited the IT/Office Manager to join the Management Team on a provisional basis. The Director has now decided to permanently include the IT/Office Manager in the Management Team structure and also to reflect this change in the post title. Therefore, the post title has changed from 'IT/Office Manager' to 'Head, Information Technology' (see document IOPC/MAR21/7/1).
- 1.3 The Director is therefore proposing changes to Regulation 12 in respect of the delegation of authority by removing the Legal Counsel and including the Head of the Information Technology Department. The proposed amendments to Internal Regulation 12 of the 1992 Fund are at the Annex.
- 1.4 It is further proposed that the corresponding amendments also be made to the Internal Regulations of the Supplementary Fund.

2 Action to be taken

1992 Fund Assembly

- 2.1 The 1992 Fund Assembly is invited to approve the proposed amendments to Internal Regulation 12 in respect of the delegation of authority.

Supplementary Fund Assembly

- 2.2 The Supplementary Fund Assembly is invited to note the decision of the 1992 Fund Assembly and approve the corresponding amendments to Internal Regulation 12 in respect of the delegation of authority.

ANNEX

INTERNAL REGULATIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL OIL POLLUTION COMPENSATION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THE 1992 FUND CONVENTION

(Proposed deletions are indicated by strikethrough of the text. New text is indicated in bold.)

Regulation 12

Delegation of authority in the absence of the Director

The Director may authorise the Deputy Director/Head of the Finance and Administration Department, the Head of the External Relations and Conference Department, the Head of the Claims Department, or the ~~Legal Counsel~~ **Head of the Information Technology Department** in that order, to act on his behalf in the fulfilment of the functions set out in Article 29 of the 1992 Fund Convention, and to be the legal representative of the 1992 Fund. The conditions and extent of such delegation shall be laid down in Administrative Instructions issued by the Director. Delegation made in accordance with this Regulation overrides any limitation of the authority of the above-mentioned officers contained elsewhere in these Regulations or in the Financial Regulations.

If there is no one of the said senior members of the Secretariat available to assume the function of the Director, the Chair of the 1992 Fund Assembly shall appoint a member of the Secretariat, other than those mentioned in the preceding paragraph, to carry out this function until the next regular or extraordinary session of the Assembly or until any of the said senior members of the Secretariat has been able to resume their responsibilities.
