STATUS OF THE 1992 FUND CONVENTION AND THE SUPPLEMENTARY FUND PROTOCOL

Note by the Secretariat

Summary:	At the opening of the 26th session of the 1992 Fund Assembly in November 2021, 118 States will be Parties to the 1992 Fund Convention. Thirty-two States are Parties to the Supplementary Fund Protocol. The Member States of the 1992 Fund and Supplementary Fund are set out at the Annex to this document.
Action to be taken:	<u>1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly</u> Information to be noted.

1 1992 Fund Convention

- 1.1 At the opening of the 26th session of the 1992 Fund Assembly in November 2021, 118 States will be Members of the 1992 Fund, as set out at the Annex.
- 1.2 The 1992 Fund Convention entered into force for the Republic of Nauru on 23 March 2021.
- 1.3 The Republic of San Marino and the Republic of Costa Rica acceded to the 1992 Fund Convention on 19 April 2021 and 19 May 2021, respectively. The Convention will enter into force for these States during 2022, bringing the number of 1992 Fund Member States to 120 by 19 May 2022.

2 Supplementary Fund Protocol

At the opening of the 18th session of the Supplementary Fund Assembly in November 2021, 32 States will be Members of the Supplementary Fund. There have been no further accessions to the Supplementary Fund Protocol since 2018.

3 Action to be taken

1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly
