PROVISIONAL AGENDA FOR THE MARCH 2022 SESSIONS OF THE IOPC FUNDS GOVERNING BODIES

*Tuesday, 29 March to Wednesday, 30 March 2022
to be held remotely via KUDO*

1 Introduction

- 1.1 This document contains a provisional timetable and agenda for the March 2022 sessions of the IOPC Funds governing bodies. The following sessions of the governing bodies will be convened:

- 1.2 The meeting will be held remotely via KUDO from Tuesday, 29 March 2022 to Wednesday, 30 March 2022. The working hours each day will be from 11.00 am to 2.00 pm (UTC+1)^{<1>}, with one 15-minute break. Quorum for each of the governing bodies is established at the opening of the sessions on Tuesday at 11.00 am and, therefore, delegates are requested to be logged into KUDO by that time.
- 1.3 For any delegates that wish to test their connectivity through the KUDO platform in advance of the virtual meeting, the Secretariat will be holding an onboarding session from 11.00 am to 12.00 pm on Monday, 28 March 2022.
- 1.4 In line with the recent practice adopted in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the upcoming meeting will be convened remotely. However, unlike the November 2021 meeting, since the audio-visual facilities of the IMO main hall and committee rooms are currently undergoing refurbishment, delegates will not be able to follow the remote meeting from the IMO building on this occasion (IMO circular letter No.4220/Add.11).
- 1.5 Important information about the presentation of credentials and notifications, and registration for the virtual meeting is provided at Annex I. Please note that only those delegates who have registered and submitted credentials in advance of the meeting will be sent a link and joining instructions to the virtual meeting. Further details on technical recommendations for participating in the virtual meeting will be issued in document IOPC/MAR22/1/4.

^{<1>} Please note that the United Kingdom's daylight saving time starts on Sunday, 27 March 2022, whereby the clocks are set one hour ahead to British Summer Time (BST). BST is equivalent to (GMT+1) or (UTC+1).

1.7 The Director, in consultation with the Chairs, has prepared a provisional timetable and agenda found below. ANNEX I

INFORMATION ON CREDENTIALS AND REGISTRATION TO THE MARCH 2022 MEETING OF THE IOPC FUNDS' GOVERNING BODIES

1 Credentials and notifications

- 1.1 In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, credentials or notifications are required in respect of sessions of each of the following governing bodies for representatives, alternates and other persons designated by governments and organisations to attend the meeting:

- 1.2 Credentials and notifications should be addressed to the Director of the IOPC Funds (i.e. not to the Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization (IMO)).
- 1.3 Detailed guidance in respect of the form and content of credentials and notifications is given in circular IOPC/2015/Circ.4 which is available on the Document Services website. In this context, delegates are reminded that if credentials are not issued by the Head of State, the Head of Government, the Minister of Foreign Affairs or the Ambassador/High Commissioner, a letter from the appropriate authority appointing the person authorised to issue the credentials for sessions of the IOPC Funds governing bodies should be provided to the Director of the IOPC Funds.

2 Credentials for remote sessions

- 2.1 Following the process noted by the governing bodies at their first remote meeting in December 2020, for practical reasons, it is very important that delegations submit credentials via the online registration system or by email in advance of the meeting, and no later than **Friday, 11 March 2022**.
- 2.2 The Secretariat will do all it can to facilitate participation of delegations who submit credentials up to the opening day of the sessions, however, late submissions may lead to delays in providing links to access the KUDO platform on time for the opening of the sessions.

4 Registration
