#### Note by the Credentials Committee

<b>Summary:</b>	The Credentials Committee has examined the credentials of delegations of 1992 Fund Member States and submits the following interim report.

### 1 Introduction

1.1 In accordance with Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Assembly and of the Supplementary Fund Assembly and Rule 9 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Executive Committee, the 1992 Fund Assembly appointed a Credentials Committee consisting of the following five members and their representatives:

United Kingdom (Mr Shaun Rogers)  
Uruguay (Captain Frederick Fontanot)

1.2 The Credentials Committee met in person on 7 November 2023, chaired by Mr Mohd Fairoz Bin Rozali and prepared this report.

### 2 Examination of credentials

2.1 The credentials of delegations of the 1992 Fund Member States were examined by the Credentials Committee. The Credentials Committee based its deliberations on Rules 9 and 11 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Assembly and on the guidelines given in circular IOPC/2023/Circ.6.

2.2 The Credentials Committee presents this report in accordance with Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the 1992 Fund Assembly.

2.3 The Credentials Committee found that 72 Member States of the 1992 Fund had submitted credentials which were found to be in order as at 2 pm on 7 November 2023. Those Member States are therefore eligible to vote in the election of the joint Audit Body and are listed at the Annex attached to this interim report.

- 2.4 The Credentials Committee noted that two Member States had submitted credentials after the exceptionally extended deadline decided by the 1992 Fund Assembly at the opening of the session. Those credentials were therefore not accepted for examination.
