**Notice of accession to the 1992 Fund Protocol  
by Antigua and Barbuda, India and Lithuania**

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1992 (1992 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that instruments of accession to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1992 Fund Protocol) were deposited by Antigua and Barbuda, India and Lithuania on 14 June 2000, 21 June 2000 and 27 June 2000, respectively. The 1992 Fund Protocol will enter into force for Antigua and Barbuda on 14 June 2001, for India on 21 June 2001 and for Lithuania on 27 June 2001.

The 59 States which have deposited instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession in respect of the 1992 Fund Protocol are listed overleaf.
