Notice of accession to the 1992 Fund Protocol by Sierra Leone and Cambodia

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1992 (1992 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that instruments of accession to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1992 Fund Protocol) were deposited by Sierra Leone on 4 June 2001 and by Cambodia on 8 June 2001. The 1992 Fund Protocol will enter into force for Sierra Leone on 4 June 2002 and for Cambodia on 8 June 2002.

The 66 States which have deposited instruments of ratification acceptance, approval or accession in respect of the 1992 Fund Protocol are listed overleaf.
