Notice of accession to the 1992 Fund Protocol by Mozambique, Madagascar, Nigeria and Gabon

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1992 (1992 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that instruments of accession to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1992 Fund Protocol) were deposited by the Republic of Mozambique on 26 April 2002, by the Republic of Madagascar on 21 May 2002, by the Federal Republic of Nigeria on 24 May 2002 and by the Gabonese Republic on 31 May 2002. The 1992 Fund Protocol will enter into force for the Republic of Mozambique on 26 April, for the Republic of Madagascar on 21May 2003, for the Federal Republic of Nigeria on 24 May 2003 and for Gabonese Republic on 31 May 2003.

The 80 States which have deposited instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession in respect of the 1992 Fund Protocol are listed overleaf.
