## Notice of accession to the 1992 Fund Protocol by Cape Verde

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1992 (1992 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that an instrument of accession to the Protocol of 1992 to amend the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1992 Fund Protocol) was deposited by the Republic of Cape Verde on 4 July 2003. The 1992 Fund Protocol will enter into force for the Republic of Cape Verde on 4 July 2004.

The 86 States which have deposited instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession in respect of the 1992 Fund Protocol are listed overleaf.
