Notice of Denunciation of the 1971 Fund Convention by Barbados, Venezuela and Croatia

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1971 (1971 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that, following the deposit of instruments of denunciation, the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1971 Fund Convention) will cease to be in force for Barbados after 7 July 1999, for Venezuela after 22 July 1999, and for Croatia after 30 July 1999.

A list of the 52 Contracting States to the 1971 Fund Convention, including the States which have deposited instruments of denunciation, appears overleaf.
