## Notice of the Entry into Force of the 1971 Fund Convention for Panama

In accordance with Regulation 4.6 of the Internal Regulations of the International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund 1971 (1971 Fund), the Director has the honour to notify Contracting States that the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage, 1971 (1971 Fund Convention) will enter into force for the Republic of Panama on 16 June 1999.

A list of the 53 Contracting States to the 1971 Fund Convention, including the 11 States which have deposited instruments of denunciation, appears overleaf.
