**Document Services website:
Multi-language interface and other new features now operational**

The Document Services website, launched by the Secretariat in August 2011, provides online access to all meeting documents and circulars in English, French and Spanish. However, to facilitate the development phase, the interface of the Document Services website, as well as the Decisions Database, one of the tools of the site, was initially created in English only. The Secretariat is delighted to announce that the IOPC Funds' Document Services website, including the Decisions Database, is now fully operational in French and Spanish. Users can select their preferred language at the top right hand side of any page of the website.

All documents for the upcoming meetings of the IOPC Funds' governing bodies, to be held from 15-19 October 2012, will be made available via the Document Services site in the usual way. Delegates are encouraged to register on the site and subscribe to receive email notification of newly published documents in their preferred language.

The provisional Agenda for the October meetings is already available on the site. A new feature added to the site in August 2012 is the introduction of links to background documents within meeting documents. These hyperlinks, which should assist readers of documents by providing instant access to background documents, will be included in all future meeting documents.

Online registration for the October meetings is now open. Delegates can register via the Document Services site at <http://documentservices.iopcfund.org/meeting-registration/>.

The Secretariat has also added an option within the 'My Account' section of the website to receive notification of newly published circulars, which are issued from time to time.
