SHARING OF JOINT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS WITH THE 1971 FUND

Note by the Director

1 At its 1st session, the Assembly agreed that the costs of running the 1992 Fund and 1971 Fund's joint Secretariat should, for the period 30 May to 31 December 1996, be distributed with $\frac{1}{4}$ to be paid by the 1992 Fund and $\frac{3}{4}$ by the 1971 Fund, and that the distribution for subsequent periods should be decided yearly by the Assemblies of the two Funds (document 92FUND/A.1/34, paragraph 22).

2 At its 1st extraordinary session, the Assembly decided that the costs of running the joint Secretariat should for 1997 be distributed with 70% to be paid by the 1971 Fund and 30% by the 1992 Fund (document 92FUND/A/ES.1/22, paragraph 16).

3 The Director is of the view that during 1998 the ratio of administrative work between the 1992 Fund and the 1971 Fund will differ from the situation in 1997. Although it is not possible to make any accurate estimate, the Director considers that a somewhat greater proportion of the Secretariat's work will fall on the 1992 Fund during 1998 than in 1997. He therefore proposes that, for 1998, the joint administrative costs of the two Organisations should be distributed with 40% to be paid by the 1992 Fund and 60% by the 1971 Fund. In the Director's view, however, this distribution should not apply to certain items in respect of which it will be possible to make a distribution based on the actual costs to be incurred by each Organisation, as set out in the explanatory notes to the draft budget for 1998 (document 92FUND/A.2/24).

Action to be taken by the Assembly

4 The Assembly is invited to consider the apportionment of joint administrative costs between the 1992 Fund and the 1971 Fund for the period 1 January to 31 December 1998.
