## STATUS OF THE 1992 FUND CONVENTION AND THE SUPPLEMENTARY FUND PROTOCOL

### Note by the Secretariat

**Summary:** As at 14 August 2019, 115 States are Parties to the 1992 Fund Convention. Thirty-two States are Parties to the Supplementary Fund Protocol. The Member States of the 1992 Fund and Supplementary Fund are set out at the Annex to this document.

**Action to be taken:** 1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly  
Information to be noted.

### 1 1992 Fund Convention

- 1.1 At the opening of the 24th session of the 1992 Fund Assembly in October 2019, 115 States will be Members of the 1992 Fund, as set out at the Annex.
- 1.2 The Co-operative Republic of Guyana acceded to the 1992 Fund Convention on 20 February 2019. The Convention will enter into force for this State during 2020, bringing the number of 1992 Fund Member States to 116 by 20 February 2020 as set out at the Annex.

### 2 Supplementary Fund Protocol

- 2.1 At the opening of the 16th session of the Supplementary Fund Assembly in October 2019, 32 States will be Members of the Supplementary Fund.
- 2.2 New Zealand was the 32nd State to join the Supplementary Fund, with the Protocol having entered into force for the State on 29 September 2018.

### 3 Action to be taken

#### 1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly

The 1992 Fund Assembly and Supplementary Fund Assembly are invited to take note of the information contained in this document.
