## RESOLUTION

THE SECOND SESSION OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE INTERNATIONAL DIL POLLUTION COMPENSATION FUND,

HAVING DECIDED to raise the limit of 450 million france referred to in paragraph 4, sub-paragraph (a) and (b) of Article 4 of the International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Oil Pollution Damage 1971, to 675 million france,

DECIDED to request IMCO to consider the desirability of revising the 1969 International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage and the 1971 International Convention on the Establishment of an International Fund for Oil Pollution Damage, in the light of this decision especially looking into the adequacy of the limits laid down by the two Conventions, the feasibility of changing the limits in either or both of the Conventions, as well as the problems caused by the limits applicable under the 1969 International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage to smaller tankers, and the system of relieving the shipowner under Article 2, paragraph 1(b) of the 1971 Convention.
