Note by the Director


1. The Assembly, at its first extraordinary session, approved the Director's suggestion to have an emblem created for the IOPC Fund. The Assembly raised an appropriation in the budget 1981 for the purpose of employing a professional designer.

2. The designer employed by the Fund submitted several alternatives for an emblem which are reproduced at Annex I. In addition, some other designs have been gratuitously submitted to the Fund Secretariat by friends. These designs are at Annex II.

3. The Assembly is invited to consider the designs, as reproduced in the Annexes, for the possible adoption of one as the IOPC Fund's emblem.
