ELECTION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Note by the Director

1 The present members of the Executive Committee, elected at the fourth session of the Fund's Assembly, hold office until the end of the fifth session of the Assembly, in accordance with Article 23.1 of the Fund Convention. Members of the present Executive Committee are France, Federal Republic of Germany, Italy and United Kingdom elected under Article 22.2(b) of the Fund Convention, and Ghana, Indonesia, Norway and Yugoslavia elected under Article 22.2(a). The Assembly is invited to elect new members of the Executive Committee who shall hold office until the end of the next regular session of the Assembly.

2 At the time of the fifth session of the Assembly, the IOPC Fund will have 25 Members. Therefore, according to Article 22.1 of the Fund Convention, nine Members of the Assembly have to be elected to the Executive Committee. Four Members have to be elected in accordance with Article 22.2(b) of the Fund Convention, and five Members in accordance with Article 22.2(a).

3 Article 23.2 of the Fund Convention provides that no Member may serve on the Executive Committee for more than two consecutive terms of office, except to the extent that this may be necessary to comply with the requirements of Article 22 of the Fund Convention. Ghana and Indonesia, eligible under Article 22.2(a) of the Fund Convention, as well as the Federal Republic of Germany and Italy, eligible under Article 22.2(b), have been members of the Executive Committee for two consecutive terms.

4 According to Rule 41 of the Rules of Procedure, ballots shall first be held for the election of the four members under Article 22.2(b). Thereafter ballots shall be held for the election of the remaining five members under Article 22.2(a).

5 With reference to the election of members under Article 22.2(b), the information on the 1981 figures for contributing oil receipts is given in Annex I. With respect to those States who had not submitted their reports on the 1981 receipts at the time of the drafting of this document, the 1980 figures are given.

6 With reference to the election of members under Article 22.2(a), information on the oil tanker fleets of Member States as at 1 July 1981 is given in Annex II.
