AMENDMENTS TO STAFF RULES

Note by the Director

General Service Salary Scale

- As reported in paragraph 7.1 of document FUND/EXC.14/5, a new salary scale was introduced as regards IMO and IOPC Fund staff members in the General Service category, with effect from 1 September 1984. This scale is subject to interim adjustments in accordance with the recommendations of the International Civil Service Commission.
- The requirement for a first interim adjustment was met in April 1985. The Secretary-General of IMO has given effect to this adjustment by introducing a new General Service salary scale, with effect from 1 May 1985, to replace the scale in force since 1 September 1984 (IMO document ADMIN/85/37). The increase in salaries amounts to 4.9% net.
- 3 The Director has introduced the corresponding new scale for staff in the General Service category, with effect from 1 May 1985, to reflect the salary increases within IMO. This new scale, which is reproduced overleaf, forms a new Annex E to the IOPC Fund's Staff Rules.
- 4 The Executive Committee is invited to take note of the information contained in this document.
