INFORMATION ON AND APPROVAL OF SETTLEMENT OF CLAIMS

Note by the Director

1 Introduction

Since the issuance of document FUND/EXC.22/3/Add.1, further developments have taken place with regard to the ANTONIO GRAMSCI incident.

2 ANTONIO GRAMSCI

(Finland, 6 February 1987)

2.1 At the meeting in Riga on 4 and 5 October 1989, the claim submitted by the Estonian State Committee for Environmental Protection and Forestry was also questioned with regard to the application of the "metodika". The calculation of the amount of damage claimed was based on the quantity of oil allegedly collected in USSR territorial waters. The experts used by the IOPC Fund and the UK Club maintained, however, that the quantity of oil actually collected in USSR territorial waters was less than the quantity used for the purpose of these calculations.

2.2 The Estonian State Committee has re-examined the documentation and found that some oil was actually collected outside USSR territorial waters. The Committee has therefore revised the calculations and reduced the amount claimed from Rbls712 200 (£712 985) to Rbls436 448 (£436 930).

2.3 The situation in respect of the claims against the limitation fund established with the Court in Riga can be summarised as follows:

2.4 The limitation amount applicable to the ANTONIO GRAMSCI is Rbls2 431 854 (£2 434 530).
