## RECORD OF DECISIONS OF THE TWENTY-FIFTH SESSION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

(held on 27 September 1990)

### Opening of the Session

The session was opened by Mr W W Sturms (Netherlands), in his capacity as representative of the delegation from which the Chairman of the previous Executive Committee was elected.

### 1 Adoption of the Agenda

The Executive Committee adopted the Agenda as contained in document FUND/EXC.25/1.

### 2 Election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman

2.1 The Executive Committee elected the following delegates to hold office until the next regular session of the Assembly:
