## INCIDENTS INVOLVING THE IOPC FUND BRAER

## **CLAIMS SITUATION**

## Note by the Director

- 1 Few developments have taken place in the proceedings in the Court of session in Edinburgh since the Executive Committee's 47th session.
- 2 A detailed analysis of the claims filed in the court proceedings was given in document FUND/EXC.47/4.
- 3 A summary of the claims pending in the court proceedings as at 20 June 1996 is given in Annex I of this document and a breakdown of the claims relating to the salmon and fishery industries is contained in Annexes II and III, respectively.
- It should be noted that four claims relating to loss of income allegedly suffered by salmon farmers as a result of price damage have been withdrawn during June 1996. The claim of the largest salmon farm within the exclusion zone imposed by the United Kingdom Government has now been settled and its £1 million price damage claim has also been withdrawn. In addition, five claims totalling £79 575 were also withdrawn during June 1996. These claims related to costs and fees incurred by the fish farms' insurers following the incident.

## 5 Action to be taken by the Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is invited to take note of the information contained in this document.
