- ▶ Treaty Law Problems Arising out of Amendments to the Entry into Force Provisions of the 1984 Protocols to the 1969 Civil Liability Convention and the 1971 Fund Convention (FUND/WGR.6/10)
- ▶ Examination of the Contribution Scheme under the 1971 Fund Convention and the 1984 Protocol thereto (FUND/WGR.6/11)
