**1     Adoption of the Agenda**

**2     Election of Chairman**

The Working Group will be invited to elect a Chairman for the meeting.

**3     Criteria for the Admissibility of Claims**

Pursuant to the mandate given by the Assembly, the Working Group should:

- (a) examine the general criteria for the admissibility of claims for compensation for "pollution damage" and "preventive measures" within the scope of the 1969 Civil Liability Convention and the 1971 Fund Convention and the 1992 Protocols thereto;
- (b) study in particular problems relating to claims in respect of so-called "pure economic loss" and "preventive measures" taken to prevent or minimise pure economic loss;

- (c) consider problems relating to the admissibility of claims for environmental damage within the scope of the definition of "pollution damage" referred to above; and
- (d) study the procedures to be applied by the IOPC Fund in the assessment and settlement of claims.

**4 Future Sessions of the Working Group**

The Working Group will be invited to consider whether a further meeting would be necessary to complete its work.

**5 Adoption of the Report to the Assembly**

The Working Group will be invited to consider the procedure for preparing its report to the Assembly.
