GRANT OF OBSERVER STATUS

Note by the Director

1 The Government of Brunei Darussalam deposited its instrument of accession to the Fund Convention on 29 September 1992. The Convention will thus enter into force in respect of Brunei Darussalam on 28 December 1992.

2 The Director has been informed that the Governments of the Republic of Colombia and the Republic of Ecuador are considering accession to the Fund Convention. These Governments have requested to be given observer status with the IOPC Fund.

3 In accordance with Rule 4 of the Rules of Procedure and after consultation with the Chairmen of the Assembly and Executive Committee, the Director has invited the Governments of Brunei Darussalam, Colombia and Ecuador to send observers to the 15th session of the Assembly and to the 32nd session of the Executive Committee.

Action to be Taken by the Assembly

4 The Assembly is invited to:

- (a) note the Director's invitation to the Government of Brunei Darussalam to send observers to the above-mentioned sessions; and
 - (b) approve the application of the Republic of Colombia and the Republic of Ecuador for observer status.
